Prime Minister marks 11 Years of Make in India initiative

On 25th September 2025, the Prime Minister (PM) Narendra Modi marked the 11th anniversary of the '**Make in India**' initiative, celebrating its transformative impact on India's economic landscape and entrepreneurial ecosystem.

- **What?** Make in India – 11th Anniversary

- **Launched:** 25th Sept 2014

- **Led by:** DPIIT, MoC&I

- **Pillars:** New process, new infrastructure, new sectors, new mindset

- **Make in India 2.0:** 2 sectors

About Make in India:

Launched on: The initiative

was launched on September 25, 2014 by the PM to transform India into a global hub for design and manufacturing.

Objective: It was launched with the objective of facilitating investment, fostering innovation, building best in class manufacturing infrastructure, making it easy to do business and enhancing skill development.

It is being led by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (**DPIIT**), Ministry of Commerce and Industry (MoC&I), Government of India (GoI).

FIFA Unveils Trio of Mascots for 2026 World Cup

In September 2025, the Fédération Internationale de Football Association (**FIFA**) unveiled three

official mascots: '**Clutch, Zayu and Maple**' for the **23rd FIFA World Cup** (2026), with each host

country represented by a distinct character.

•The FIFA World Cup 2026 will be co-hosted by the United States, Mexico, and Canada from

June 26 to July 19, 2026, marking the first time the tournament is held across three countries.



India's First-Ever Gold at Speed Skating World Championship

Won by Anandkumar Velkumar and Krish Sharma .

- **Tournament host** : China
- Anandkumar Velkumar won the gold medal in the senior men's 1000m sprint which became India's first medal in the senior category at the World Championships.
- Krish Sharma clinched gold in the junior 1000m sprint.





India gets it's 15th Vice President

- **Name** : CP Radhakrishnan (was NDA's candidate for the Vice President post)
- He superceded Jagdeep Dhankar (14th Vice President)
- **About Vice President of India (static pionters to remember):**
- 1st Vice President of India : Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan
- Article 63 of the Indian constitution says that there shall be a Vice President of India.
- **Eligibility to become a Vice President:**
- Must have Indian citizenship.
- Aged 35 years or above.
- Qualified to become a Rajya Sabha member.
- Should not hold any "office of profit" under central or state governments.



Nepal get its first Woman Prime Minister

- Name : Sushila Karki (Former Chief Justice of Nepal)
- Chosen by Gen-Z protest groups on Discord.

- **About Gen-Z protest :**

- Led by young Nepalis frustrated with corruption and governance failures.
- Reason : Attempt of the government to impose a ban on social media platforms.
- This protest forced widespread resignations from older political leaders which includes former PM KP Sharma Oli.

India's 7 More Sites Included in Tentative List of UNESCO's World Heritage Sites 2025, Total Increases to 69

In September 2025, the **Permanent Delegation of India** to United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation (**UNESCO**) announced the inclusion of **7** Indian properties/sites under the 'Natural Category' in the Tentative List of UNESCO's World Heritage Convention



- With this, the total number of Indian sites on the list increases to **69**, including **49** under Cultural category, **3** under Mixed Category and **17** under Natural Category.
